To qualify as a DHS volunteer, you must be a current, active, and unencumbered licensure or certification for the following healthcare professionals:

- o Registered Nurse or Licensed Practical Nurse/Licensed Vocational Nurse
- Nurse Practitioner/ Advanced PRN
- o Certified Nursing Assistant or Physician Assistant
- Medical Doctor or Doctor of Osteopathy
- o Emergency Medical Technician or Paramedic
