Good News & Recognitions:

<u>Meeting Minute Approval:</u> Minutes from the October 19, 2022 meeting were reviewed and approved. Motion for approval made by Joan Hengst and seconded by Barb Smith. All approved.

Officer Reports:

Vice-President: Denise Holida had no report

Secretary: Pam Kalkhoff reported she had information from former secretary Penny Smith to follow so the transition should also be smooth.

Treasurer: Becky Davila submitted a financial report. She also reported that we have about a \$9400/year of expenses. The total of IANNs account is higher than that.

Chair Reports:

Barb Smith reported on the Iowa Neonatal Quality Collaborative (INQC). More will be discussed under new business.

Penny Smith also reported on the march of dimes and their upcoming walks.

Old Business:

IANN Website: https://iann.nursingnetwork.com Penny is working on having the whole board to have access and editing rights to this website.

Ronald McDonald House dinners: Becky reported that the checks were sent to all 4 Ronald McDonald Houses. When discussing plans for 2023, Penny brought up that Sioux City also has a Ronald McDonald House. Tho we currently do not have any members from there, we felt we should support them, too. Erin Burns motioned that we would give \$500 to all 5 houses for 2023. Cyndie Homewood seconded. All approved. Becky will take care of this.

New Business:

IANN Bylaws: The Bylaws were silently reviewed. Denise Holida motioned that the Bylaws be approved as written. Susan Berends seconded. All approved.

Barb Smith presented a proposal for the Iowa Neonatal Quality Collaborative (INQC) to receive a grant from IANN for \$5000. They are a non-profit organization that supports quality improvement for neonatal care in Iowa. Discussion was held with questions on exactly how the money would be spent and if we could offer a smaller amount. The request was tabled until Barb Smith could answer the money questions. Penny Smith and Barb will recuse themselves from the actual vote due to their involvement with the organization.

Professional Development Virtual Fair: Penny and Emily will present on NANN/IANN.

IANN will have a booth there free of charge. Penny asked if anyone would be available to man the booth. Cyndie Homewood said she may be able to.

The 2023 NANN Conference will be held in Anaheim, CA. IANN Scholarships are available for any member who would like to attend on a first come first served basis.

Open Forum: Moving Forward:

Pam Kalkhoff proposed that IANN set up a grant program for groups within our hospitals that help support our neonates. To enable the healthcare team to provide evidence-based care, education and support to breastfeeding parents and their families.


Continuing Education

Deadline to register is Wednesday, May 10, 2023 at 9:00 a.m. CST. Registration is online only.


