Thank you for participating in the 2023 Inaugural Parade for Governor Andy Beshear. The parade is an important part of the celebration.

Below are instructions for Tuesday, December 12, 2023.

Only active parade unit members will be allowed in the staging area. Parents are encouraged to attend, but should park in the public parking areas and take shuttles to reach the parade route.

1. The staging area for bands will be at the State Office Building at 501 High Street. Units will take Exit 58 off of Interstate 64, and will arrive via U.S. 60 and U.S. 421 South, which will bring you to the Owenton/Frankfort Exit for North 127/2261. You will then go right to Frankfort/2261, then go to Holmes Street. There will be Police and National Guard to direct you.
2. All parade units should plan to arrive by 8:00 a.m.
3. The parade route is one (1) mile long. **NO UNIT** will stop to perform at any time during the parade.
4. NOTE: All units must walk **NOT MARCH** across the Capitol Avenue Bridge.
5. All unit members must be in uniforms and ready to assemble upon arrival at the staging area. There will be portable restrooms available at the staging area, as well as refreshments and snacks. Although portable restrooms will be available, we recommend that all groups take a restroom break before arriving at the staging area.
6. Bus instructions listed below:
 - All units must enter the staging area by Holmes Street. SEE ATTACHED MAP. Please try to arrive in as few vehicles as possible. **It is extremely important that no buses arrive via any other route.**



- Band parents should not enter the staging area. We have limited space and are coordinating over 150 buses. Parents should proceed to the shuttle parking area behind the Cabinet for Human Resources Building, 275 E. Main Street.
- There will be officials positioned throughout the parade staging area on Holmes Street to assist you. Again, all units will be arriving via U.S. 421 South to Holmes Street.
- After your bus is unloaded, the National Guard will escort all buses to Shelby Street for parking. Shelby Street is located at the end of the parade route where all unit members will load back onto their buses. **BUS DRIVERS MUST REMAIN WITH BUSES** in case they need to be moved due to an emergency. Buses will be directed from the drop-off staging areas to Mero Street, then to the West Frankfort Plaza Connector, then to Louisville Road, then to Tanglewood Drive, and then to Shelby Street for post-parade pickup staging.

7. For Grand Marshals, you may park at the Cabinet for Health and Family Services off of Martin Luther King Blvd., beginning at 8:00 a.m. and ride a shuttle to 4th Street and Logan Street, then walk to Capitol Avenue and ride a shuttle to the Kentucky History Center, which is near the staging area at 501 High Street. Shuttles will be available to take you back to the Cabinet for Human Resources Building after the parade. Otherwise, you may park in the parking garage at either the Mayo-Underwood Building at 500 Mero Street or the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet at 200 Mero Street.
