- Go straight from BSN to DNP: No RN experience required
- No GRE required
- Distance-accessible* doctoral program
- For nurses with a baccalaureate or master's degree in nursing
- Mix of online classes, on-campus intensives, webinars
- Both concentrations emphasize rural care
- Program promotes culture of collegiality, scholarship, innovation, and professionalism
- Small class sizes with mixed cohorts of FNP/PMHNP students
- All NP faculty are nationally certified and engage in clinical practice

A Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree prepares students to excel in a career as a registered nurse and lays the groundwork for graduate studies. At UW, students can attain their BSN through one of the following options:



Basic BSN

- Four-year on-campus Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN)
- Freshmen meeting specified criteria considered for admission
- Clinical nursing courses begin in sophomore year (4th semester)
- “Small school” atmosphere in nursing major
- Marcia Dale Aspire Scholars Program (leadership opportunity)
- State-of-the-art Clinical Simulation Center and classrooms
- Use of technology and active learning throughout curriculum
- Total of 1,125 clinical hours in curriculum
- Full semester senior capstone practicum (spring of senior year)
