Putting on a day-long conference is a big job, and this group was a well-oiled machine. Mary Coughlin, MS, NNP, RNC-E, our keynote speaker and national expert on Trauma Informed Care did not disappoint. I know we all learned a lot from her and the Professional Panel of experts she moderated. Terry Johnson, APN, NNP-BC (always a fan favorite) gave a great talk on the benefits of an exclusive human milk diet for NICU babies. And, our own Becky Chuffo Davila, DNP, NNP-BC updated the group on her groundbreaking work with Listening Visits in NICU. The food was excellent, the vendors were happy and engaging, and the attendee reviews were overwhelmingly positive. Thanks again to everyone who participated in the annual conference. I walked away from the venue feeling very proud to be associated with such a great group of Iowa nurses!

I was privileged to attend the national NANN conference held in Anaheim, CA, September 26-28, along with two NICU nurses and four nurse practitioners from UI Stead Family Children's Hospital. If you ever get the opportunity to attend the national conference, I hope you take advantage and GO! It really is an amazing experience. And it seems like the educational bar is raised a little every year related to the quantity and quality of pertinent topics and smart, engaging speakers. The exhibit hall was filled

with vendors eager to teach us about the latest innovations in neonatal care. I think every lowa nurse there came back with a hit list of new products to explore. One vendor stood out for me this year. Many of you use the Zaky HUG® in your unit as a therapeutic positioning device. We have used them at UISFCH since they first came on the market. Well, I was pleased to share apps and drinks with the creator of the Zaky at the President's Reception on the first night of the conference. Everyone at the table was spellbound as she shared her story of how the Zaky was born. The product is named after her son, Zachary. Zach was born at 28 weeks' gestation in 2001 in a hospital in Houston, TX. He had the typical preemie course for a 28-weeker born in that era, no major complications. When Zach was three weeks old, Tropical Storm Allison hit Houston. The hospital was completely without power for 9 hours. During that very long, dark night in the NICU, Yamile held Zach skin-toskin to keep him warm. Dad Larry took shifts with the nurses, hand-bagging (ventilating) Zach via his ET tube. After that harrowing night, Yamile really struggled, like most NICU moms, to leave her baby and go home each night. Yamile put her engineering degrees to work and developed the Zaky hand which of course worked like a charm to soothe little Zach when mom and dad couldn't be there to support him. The story doesn't end there. A couple years later, Yamile turned her focus toward promoting Kangaroo Care (KC). During this time, education and awareness about KC were lacking in NICU's. Yamile eventually developed the Zaky HUG, a device for moms that is engineered for safety, comfort, and easy access to prolong kangaroo care sessions in MBCU, NICU and PICU. On Zachary's 10th birthday, Yamile and friends started the international Kangaroo Care Awareness Day which is still celebrated today by NICU's on every continent.

Gosh, I wonder who I'll meet at NANN next year. Someone awesome and inspiring, I'm sure! I look forward to sharing a snapshot and highlights of *My Schedule* from NANN at the October chapter meeting. The Wi-Fi password at the conference

was, **wesavebabies**. I noticed as other nurses were logging in for the first time. They all had the same look, a quick, affirming smile and a little nod that said, *yep...that's what we do*. It really is a great life!

- UISFCH is expanding NICU and OB services with additional beds. Opening date is late 2025. NICU will be ~110 beds.
- Denise and Myrl Holida were recognized in the UIHC Noon News! A couple's love, legacy with UI Health Care The Loop (uiowa.edu)
- St. Luke's received Magnet redesignation
- UIHC received 5th Magnet redesignation
- ChildServe opened a campus in Hiawatha for outpatient services. Continue to be the only inpatient provider of long-term care for children with complex medical needs. Have

capacity for 10 patients for homecare nursing with 80 on homecare waitlist. During the pandemic they opened the first complex medical group home with 24/7 nursing care.

- Cindy Homewood's son is getting married in 10 days!

- Penny noted that IANN currently has around 78 members.
- Discussion was held about increasing IANN membership and encouraging those who are members to be more engaged. There are those in NICUs around lowa who are NANN members but not IANN. We will continue to try to engage through policy and resources sharing, offering CEs and programming, and we will continue NICU sharing at each meeting.

Committee Reports

Community Relations

- INQC: Penny reported that the Iowa Neonatal Quality Collaborative (INQC) is working to
 merge with the Iowa Maternal Quality Collaborative (IMQC) to form the Iowa Perinatal
 Quality Collaborative (IPQC). The IMQC has funding currently from a large HRSA grant
 for one more year. They have paid employees and currently the IMQC has
 representation from all birthing hospitals in Iowa. The INQC has 23 NICUs participating
 currently.
- An example of a project that INQC may do is a statewide neonatal encephalopathy
 registry to track metrics and standardize care. Recently all of the NICUs who provide
 therapeutic hypothermia in the state medical directors met to look at best practices.
- Iowa Statewide Perinatal Committee met 2 weeks ago. The newest guidelines will be published soon. This group is looking at substance exposure guidelines. Unsure where this will go. Screening vs testing when risk factors are identified, and if parental permission is needed to screen/test. Dennis Rosenbloom is retiring from St. Luke's this fall; he is the longtime chair of this committee. Deb Peel, MD (an OB) is the new chairperson, and the vice-chair is from Iowa DHS.
- IANN will continue to support Ronald McDonald Houses in Iowa with \$500 donation for each. Will add Ronald McDonald House Siouxland this year.
