

2024 CACNS ANNUAL CONFERENCE HOTEL RECOMMENDATIONS

JAPANTOWN

8 min by car to USF, 30 min walk

• Kabuki Hotel-JDV by Hyatt: Japantown is a fun area with lots of food options--from popular restaurants like Nari and Marufuku Ramen, to more down-home eats like sushi, takoyaki, spam musubi, boba, this place has it all (even Karaoke!). You can also find a lot of fun shops selling ceramics, clothing, home goods, and antique books. Walk up to the nearby Lafayette Park and soak up the sun (before the fog rolls in) and the bay area views.

• **Kimpton Hotel Enso**: A walking distance away (5-10 min) is the Fillmore Street. shopping district--a street lined with locally owned boutiques, restaurants, and cafes. Fancy a dress made in Kenya or Paris after eating Oysters and drinking mimosas at Little Shucker? Maybe you want to restock on your skincare after picking up croissants and kouign amanns from Boulange or having dim sum at Dumpling Story? This might be the neighborhood for you. You might also want to enjoy Mediterranean food from La Mediterannee before picking something up from Browser Books.

PRESIDIO HEIGHTS

5 min by car to USF, 20 min walk

• The Laurel Inn-JVD by Hyatt: This hotel is within walking distance to Laurel Village with some food and grocery options. Make sure you grab a cupcake from Susie Cakes. It's also a 10 minute walk from the famous Lyon Street Steps. Walk east, down the hill (about 5 min) and you'll find yourself smelling the fresh baked aromas of B Patisserie. Walk even further down (another 10 min) and you'll find yourself in the center of the Fillmore shopping district.

UPPER HAIGHT

5 min by car to USF, 15 min walk up a steep hill

• The Stanyan Park Hotel: This hotel is at the end of the famous Haight Ashbury district. It's 5 blocks from the Grateful Dead House. Here you'll find endless vintage shops, and locally owned restaurants. It's so lively that you feel like you're downtown. Just across the street is one of the main entrances into Golden Gate Park. You can rent bikes and ride around too! Within walking distance is Creola, serving Creole-style dishes and Zazie, serving up a great brunch.

THE PANHANDLE/ALAMO SQUARE

5 min by car to USF, 20 min walk

• The Metro Hotel: This hotel is right on the lively Divisadero Street where you'll find quaint restaurants, cafes, and shops on the way to USF. Nopa is a highly recommended restaurant among the locals, enjoy fresh seafood at Crudo, or grab a brisket sandwich at 4505 Eats. If you want a nice cup o' joe, walk down to The Mill. A 10 minute walk east, gets you to the famous Painted Ladies and Alamo Square Park. These were made famous by the show "Full House." Walk west from this hotel, and you'll find yourself in the Panhandle which leads you right into Golden Gate Park. This hotel is also a quick walk to Otra.

• Chateau Tivoli Bed and Breakfast: This hotel is two blocks from Alamo Square Park and just down the hill (2 blocks) from the Painted Ladies. It is about a 10 minute walk (uphill) from Divisadero Street. Care to shop? About a 10 minute walk east gets you into the heart of Hayes Valley where you'll find boutique shops, great food, and bars. Locals enjoy the German restaurant Suppenkuche, the pastries at Boulange, no frills French dining at Chez Maman, Italian food at Absinthe.

THE CASTRO

10 min by car to USF, 40 min walk (warning--hills)

• The Hotel Castro: This hotel is a boutique hotel in another fun part of the city with a lot of history and culture. It's tucked in a quiet corner of this very lively neighborhood with bars and food aplenty. Consider restaurants like Mama Ji's for Chinese food, Fable for burgers and steaks and seafood, Hot Cookie for a sweet fix, and many more. Check out beautiful views of San Francisco and the bay area at nearby Dolores Park or Twin Peaks before heading home.

CATHEDRAL HILL

10 min by car to USF, 50 min walk
