School nursing is a unique specialty practice of nursing. It intercepts pediatric, community & public health, mental health, and medical-surgical nursing. Many nurses from other settings (like hospitals) have experienced a large learning curve to understand this area of practice. In contrast, experienced school nurses who may have never taken a comprehensive class on community health nursing now have access to a comprehensive course on school nursing as a refresher.
