First, I would like to thank the officers, board members, and members of the Greater Cleveland Chapter. Because of your dedication and support we fulfilled our mission: To promote safety and optimal outcomes for patients undergoing operative and other invasive procedures by providing practice support and professional development opportunities to perioperative nurses.

Through fundraising efforts, we can offer the Annual Sherry Petryszyn Student Nurse Scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 to an eligible Nursing student, the Allen-Laing and C. Joan Gowin \$500 scholarships for qualifying Greater Cleveland Chapter members toward advanced degree in the Nursing field, and CNOR grants for qualifying Greater Cleveland Chapter members. In addition to our scholarships, we also offer stipends to our delegates representing our Chapter at AORN Expo. This year we are allotted 13 delegate seats.

Our Fundraising events include LaVera Party Center Drive-thru Dinner. This event was successful, and we will be repeating it in May.
