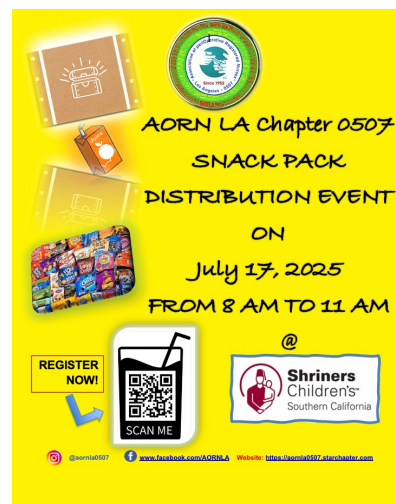

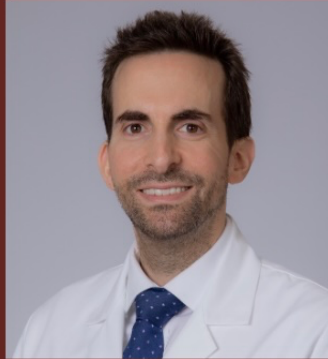

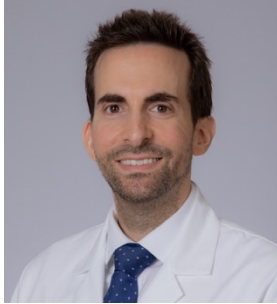

Dr. Michael Safaee, MD

Michael Safaee is a neurosurgeon specializing in the treatment of spinal disorders with a focus on scoliosis, kyphosis, tumors, and revision surgery. His research is centered on surgical outcomes in adult spinal deformity, with a particular interest in biological aging and its role in surgical risk assessment. He earned his medical degree from UCLA followed by residency in neurosurgery at UC San Francisco, and a fellowship in orthopedic spine surgery at the Johns Hopkins Hospital.

Topic: An Approach to Lumbar Interbody Fusion

Objective:

1. Understand principles of lumbar fusion
2. Understand different types of interbody fusion
3. Understand unique risks of each approach

Brief Description/Summary:

This lecture will focus on lumbar interbody fusions and the different approaches including posterior (TLIF), lateral (LLIF), and anterior (ALIF). We will review the positioning, equipment, benefits, and disadvantages of each approach. We will also review what nursing teams should be aware of for each approach.

Dr. David Reinhart is the director of surgical services and nursing, Emory Healthcare.
