NFL calls switched to Zoom in January. The next National Legislative Forum is scheduled for **Monday**, **July** 21st, at 6:30pm MT.

AORN Virtual Town Hall & Virtual Town Hall & Specia Business Meeting

Join AORN President, Darlene Murdock on **Wednesday, August 13, 2025**, for a virtual town hall and special business meeting. During the meeting, members will be asked to approve two AORN Position Statements:

- Advanced Practice Registered Nurses in the Perioperative Environment
- Care of the Transgender or Gender-Diverse Patient

Members will also learn more about AORN Governance: Delegates and Voting.

Under the AORN bylaws, a quorum of 100 members is needed for membership action between Congresses, with a minimum of at least 10 members from each of five geographic regions. Because of this requirement—and the resolution adopted in 2023 requiring membership approval of Position Statements—the following procedures must be followed to participate:

- Members <u>must pre-register for the meeting</u> with name, member ID, email address, state of residence, and phone number
- Members must attend via computer in order to vote on the position statement
- Members will be asked to suspend Robert's Rules of Order for the purposes of this electronic meeting.

Open for Public Comments: AORN Guideline for Care & Cleaning of Surgical Instruments

The AORN Guideline for Care and Cleaning of Surgical Instruments will be available for public comment June 13, 2025 - July 13, 2025 at Online Public Commenting. This document provides guidance for cleaning surgical instruments, including point-of-use treatment, transport, decontamination, inspection, and general care of reusable medical devices (eg, surgical instruments). Guidance is also provided for the selection of cleaning chemicals (eg, detergent, enzymatic cleaners, disinfectants), selection of decontamination equipment, monitoring and control of water quality, and use of personal protective equipment (PPE) that must be worn during cleaning and care of instruments. Special considerations are addressed for processing ophthalmic instruments, processing laryngoscope blades and handles, and minimizing the risk for transmitting prion diseases from contaminated reusable medical devices.

The AORN Guideline for Electrosurgical Safety will be available for public comment from July 15th through mid-August, 2025. This document provides guidance to the perioperative team for the safe use of electrosurgical units (ESUs), electrocautery devices, and argon-enhanced coagulators.
