<i>Overview</i>	From the creators of HELP Pain, Natoshia Cunningham, PhD, MSU and team bring their next program PURSUIT. The PURSUIT program aims to train school providers with a focus on school nurses and other mental health professionals to manage child mental health (including trauma), physical pain, and prevent substance use in youth.
<i>Objectives</i>	Key objectives include: 1) Increase provider knowledge of post-traumatic stress symptoms, physical pain, and the associated risk of substance misuse in pediatric populations. 2) Enhance provider understanding and use of evidence-based strategies for managing pediatric mental health concerns, pain, and substance use risk. 3) Improve provider confidence and preparedness to address mental health, pain, and substance use risk in youth, leading to more effective and comprehensive care.
<i>Course Description</i>	This course will be broken down into four sections: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Core Cognitive Behavioral Therapy Skills (2)• Pain (2)• Post Traumatic Stress Symptoms (PTSS) (1)• Substance Use (1)
