GREATER CLEVELAND AORN CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIPS



The Chapter has scholarships to assist those RNs that are advancing their careers, as well as our student nurse scholarship and CNOR Grant. Check Nursing Network or contact a Chapter Board member for information.

Qualifying members of the Greater Cleveland Chapter of AORN are eligible to apply for the **C. Joan Gowin Scholarship** of \$500.00 toward expenses (tuition/books) at the college or university of their choice. The applicant must be working toward an advanced degree in nursing.

Qualifying members of the Greater Cleveland Chapter of AORN are eligible to apply for the **Allen-Laing Scholarship** of \$500.00 toward expenses (tuition/books) at the college or university of their choice. The applicant must be working toward a BSN or higher or working toward an advanced degree in nursing, education or management/business that supports perioperative nursing.

CNOR Grant – The purpose of this grant is to encourage members to become certified or to assist with a one-time recertification.

This grant is awarded up to three (3) grants of \$400.00 each annually. A maximum of one (1) lifetime award per member. Award period will be in the fiscal year beginning July – June of respective years.

Sherry Petryszyn Student Nurse Scholarship will award one annual, \$1000 scholarship to a nursing student currently enrolled in their final year of school in an undergraduate baccalaureate, diploma, or associate degree RN program. Application deadline December of respective year.
