Post-Intensive Care Syndrome (PICS) affects between 50-80 percent of survivors of critical illness¹, and delirium is a known risk factor for developing PICS².



Physical

Muscle and nerve disease, often accompanied by chronic pain



Cognitive

Acquired brain injury resulting in trouble with memory, concentration, and executive functioning



Psychological

Depression, anxiety, and post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD)
