10 days before EMERGENCY APPLICATION START Patients may start voting in hospitals Patient Voting starts

Election Day,

Completed application must be returned to your county election office. Check addresses at https://www.sos.state.tx.us/elections/voter/county.shtml

Election Day, 7PM

EMERGENCY BALLOT DEADLINE

Voted ballot must be returned to your county election office (early voting clerk).

EMERGENCY APPLICATION DEADLINE

If you are **hospitalized up to 10 days before Election Day**, you are eligible to vote by following these steps:

- 1. Check your voter registration at www.patientvoting.com/check.
- 2. Complete absentee ballot application:
 - You must include the information listed in Sec. 84.002 of the state election code (https://statutes.capitol.texas.gov/Docs/EL/htm/EL.84.htm#84.002) on your application.
 - Your application for a late ballot must be accompanied by physician affidavit (Section 102.002 https://statutes.capitol.texas.gov/Docs/EL/htm/EL.102.htm).

Return ballot application to your county election office by **5PM on Election Day**. Check https://www.sos.state.tx.us/elections/voter/votregduties.shtml for addresses. You may deliver your ballot application:

By authorized agent (at least 18 years old). However, your authorized agent should not be employed by or related to you.

There is no submission of applications by mail in Texas.

There is no electronic submission of applications allowed in Texas.

- **4.** Receive your ballot through your authorized agent/representative.
- **5.** Vote!
- 6. Return completed ballot to your county election office (in the official carrier envelope) by 7PM on Election Day through your authorized agent. Check https://www.sos.state.tx.us/elections/voter/votregduties.shtml for addresses.
