WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

*Interested in becoming an officer for the Wyoming Nurses Association?
Here's everything you need to know to get started...*

1. Review officer position descriptions, WNA bylaws, mission and vision as well as WNA Strategic plan on the WNA homepage: Wyoming Nurses Association | Nursing Network
2. Complete electronic "Consent to Serve".
3. Prepare a 3-5 minute information video to be sent to the WNA membership. The video will be sent to the membership with voting instructions and should address the following:
 - i. Personal Introduction
 - ii. Professional Background
 - iii. Top 3 Issues facing nurses in WY
 - iv. Actions you'd like to see regarding the Top 3 issues facing nurses in WY.
4. Optional, prepare a tri-fold board or one page introduction to be available for members to get to know you and why you're interested in becoming part of the WNA board. This will be sent with voting information to the WNA membership.

WHAT IF I GET ELECTED?

1. Election results will be announced during the membership meeting on the final day of the convention.
2. At the end of convention, the current officers and elected officers will meet for brief introductions and orientation material will be handed off during this time.
3. All officers will be invited to the annual review and strategic planning session which is an in person meeting. During strategic planning officers will be fully oriented to their new role and learn more about the vision and mission of the Wyoming Nurses Association.
