Just a note...

It can be extremely difficult to keep up with the changes in how we are expected to deliver care to our patients, keep up with the advancement in treatment options, and the hardest is probably the changes in technology.

This year, MNSGNA is making a leap to a website that enables board members to have the ability to update and gather information from the website. However, this also means growing pains and challenges for members and board members. Online registration has had its struggles for many. It has several advantages, by allowing all registration material to be placed on spreadsheets; often time the written registrations are hard to read causing errors in recorded information. Enabling us to keep up to date contact information of our members gives us a way to easily communicate with our members along with other options that have not yet explored.

We are aware that registering online was a big change up, but something that needed to be done. We are hoping that people find it easier to register for our Spring Conference. Pay Pal has been available to members for several years now. We understand that some people don't like to use Pay Pal, but many people have asked to have online payment available to them and this is the best option we have found to date. We are, however, continuing to look for other options available.

Going forward, we will need to require everyone to register online for educational events. You will not be required to pay online if you are not comfortable with online payment. You will, however, need to complete your registration online up to the payment section, and then exit the website and send payment to the address listed on the registration form. Once your payment is received, you will receive confirmation and receipt of payment for your records.
