Course Description

Using the AACN blueprints, this two-day course will discuss test-taking strategies than can assist the critical care or progressive care nurse to be successful in the CCRN and PCCN Certification Exams. The course will discuss physiology, presentation, diagnosis and evaluation of the cardiac, pulmonary, neurological, gastrointestinal, renal, endocrine, and hematological systems and multisystem disorders, with a focus on questions that might be asked on the exam. It will describe abnormal behaviors and interventions for patients in progressive care units. Professional caring and ethical practices will be reviewed as described in the AACN synergy model.

A discussion of test-taking strategies will be presented. Questions similar to those found on the exams will be presented throughout, with a potpourri of questions presented at the end of the course.
