<u>Learning Outcome</u>: Registered Nurses will actively participate in the activity discussion of the implementation and outcome of a simulation based training program for nurse residents with actual patients participating as standardized patients focused on relationship building and therapeutic communication techniques to improve the patient experience, as reflected in Press-Ganey patient satisfaction scores and post-learning feedback with bedside shift report functioning as the clinical case.
