9.	Trauma/TSAC/SEQIC	Janet Houtz, State Trauma Coordinator, reported no bureau chief as the position is pending a congressional funds grant, Gared Claybaugh is the deputy director. CEU/CME for verification needs to be trauma specific. 8hour formal education and 4 hour informal education for those who care for patients during the initial resuscitation. Community level verifications are caught up, Level III to be caught up by March. Level III looking at surgeon arrival time with in 30 minutes, 48.5% are not present within 30 minutes and causes are being sought. J. Babb commended Janet on her accomplishments. SEQIC(November) Jenny P over 50% of patient are injured from falls, other trends are alcohol ingestion prior to trauma and decrease in seat belt usage. Trauma system is 10 years old, as it moves forward we are seeking a grant in order to obtain a consultation visit from ACS. TSAC (R. Adam) Looking at EMS scene times, avg is 20-25 minutes, however goal is 10-15minutes. Will start monitoring air ambulance scene times to same 10 minutes goal. Seeking reasons to delayed scene time, feedback from EMS is that they feel pressure from receiving RNs if patients arrive with no IV. Please educate your staff to not expect IV from scenes.
