6.	Trauma/Pediatric Committee	Rosie A., Joni T. There was a call on 11/13/13. Continued "angst" over ENPC and the issues with course and texts. They are preparing a 2 nd edition text with corrections. There is a comparison chart on website for ENPC/PALS/PEARS should you need info to get course reimbursed. All TNCC instructors will be notified by EMAIL of upcoming requirements for continued Instructor certification for the new TNCC edition. The manual will be issued 1/14, updates begin 2/10/14, there will be videos to watch, and a timed exam to be completed by 5/30/14. The provider manual is \$68. There is NO grace period to complete the update, if not done by 5/30/14 you may need to re-take instructor and provider course.
