## January is Cervical Cancer Awareness Month

In the United States about 14,000 women are diagnosed with invasive cervical cancer each year. Women can reduce their risk by addressing risk factors. The two most prevalent risk factors are cigarette smoking and Human Papillomavirus (HPV). Cervical cancer screening via Pap test and/or HPV test are crucial for early diagnosis.
