



Attention members! We are partnering with Education Loan Finance (ELFI) to offer you low rates on refinancing your student loans. By partnering with ELFI, you could earn \$400 when you refinance your student loans!* Apply Now!

*To begin the qualification process for the Georgia Nurses Association sign on bonus, customers must apply from the link provided on www.elfi.com/gna. Customers who are approved for and close a loan will receive the \$400 through a reduction in the principal balance of their Education Loan Finance loan when your loan has been disbursed. In order to receive this bonus, customers will be required to complete and submit a W9 form with all required documents. Taxes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. A customer will only be eligible to receive the bonus one time. Only new applicants or individuals who have never refinanced a student loan with Education Loan Finance from SouthEast Bank can receive the GNA bonus. If the new applicant was referred using the referral bonus, they will not receive the bonus provided via the referring party. If the new applicant becomes an ELFI customer, they may participate in the referral bonus by becoming the referring party. Additional terms and conditions apply. Loans are subject to credit approval.



2019 Legislative Session

The following bills have been introduced during the 2019 Legislative Session and are available for consideration.

H.B. 287 (Dubnik - Gainesville) -- PTIP; (GNA in Favor)

S.B. 76 (Black - Valdosta) -- Veterinary Nurses; (GNA in Opposition)

S.B. 106 (Tillery - Vidalia) -- "Patients First Act";
