**Type of organization:** Not-for-profit

**Meetings:** Four per year- a mix of remote and in person

**Desired area of specialty:** Family, patient-centered care, hospice or palliative care, ALS or other neurological diseases, chronic health conditions

**Experience:** 7-10 years

**Expected financial contribution:** none required; they ask Board members to give what they can and appeal to others

**Remuneration:** Reimbursement for travel expenses

**Approval/vetting process:** Candidates are asked to submit a brief letter of interest and a resume. Candidates will then meet with the ED and a member of the Nominations Committee for a brief introductory phone call. A face-to-face lunch or coffee meeting will be arranged shortly thereafter. Approved Candidates will join a meeting of the full Board during which they will be formally nominated. The Board will enter executive session vote on the nomination.

**Are there other selection criteria to be aware of?** Candidates should have a passion for helping families cope and build resilience while facing long-term illness and loss, as well as desire to empower those struggling with degenerative diseases and enable them to live with dignity. Candidates should have the skills and desire to work collaboratively and effectively as part of an impactful governance team. Our Board members are active participants in the life and work of the organization.
