For all students confirmed to a GO Team, there will be a mandatory Parent Information Meeting at 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday, Jan. 19, at North Beach on Northview's Carmel Campus. You will need to bring your student's passport and insurance cards to fill out all required paperwork in order for your child to participate in this global serving opportunity.

WHY ARE WE GOING?

In Barbados, the spiritual battle is evident and young people desperately need spiritual guidance. They know about God, but most don't have any sense of a personal connection with Him. Among the youth, there is spiritual interest, yet most haven't seen other peers who want to live life following God.

WHO DO WE PARTNER WITH?

We are partnering with Cru Barbados, which was established in 2004. There are currently 6 full-time Cru missionaries who are working with college students, families and professionals to reach the 280,000 inhabitants with the Gospel.

WHAT WORK WILL WE BE DOING?

The high school student team will come alongside the Cru staff to help launch their new high school ministry. During the school day, our students will be going into high schools to interact with Barbados teens and to share the gospel in classrooms and in person. Other activities may include helping with a sports outreach clinic, prayer walks, and facilitating small group discussion about spiritual topics.

WHO CAN GO?

This trip is open to all high school students (freshmen-seniors). An application should be submitted for this trip, and participants will then be selected based on that application. Our goal is to have students mission teams with a varying experience and talents. Participants must also obtain a valid passport. Passports that expire within six months of the travel dates will require a renewal.

HOW DO I PAY FOR THIS TRIP?

Northview Outreach believes in growing our global community to serve not only as goers, but also as senders. We firmly believe it is in the best interest and health of the GO Team participant to ask others to be a part of their global community. Asking for support from family, friends, coworkers and neighbors allows for the impact of this GO Team trip to grow exponentially. As a department, we do not organize fundraisers or provide any financial assistance for applicants. Rest assured that we will coach you through and equip you with tools to help you be successful with your personal fundraising.

ARE THERE REQUIRED VACCINATIONS?

Please contact your healthcare provider for more information and suggestions for necessary vaccinations no later than one month prior to leaving for Barbados. Recommended vaccinations or prescriptions include: Tetanus, Anti-Malaria Rx, Hepatitis A or A/B Combo and Cipro (Anti-diarrhea Rx).
