FAQ

WHY ARE WE GOING?

Haiti was once estimated to be one of the richest colonies in the Western Hemisphere. It is now listed as one of the world's poorest countries. We assist in ministering to displaced people around the Port-au-Prince area because of the 2010 earthquake.

WHO DO WE PARTNER WITH?

WHAT WORK WILL WE BE DOING?

We will come alongside and assist full-time medical staff to support mobile medical clinics at NVM's remote campuses. You may work in the pharmacy that distributes medicine to clients, or you may work at the different triage and nursing stations that assist doctors treating and diagnosing patients.

WHO CAN GO?

This is a medical-focused team. A required ratio of GO Team members need to have medical background: doctor, nurse, practitioner, surgeon, med lab tech, pharmacy, EMT, physical therapist, occupational therapist or medical assistant. There will be a limited number of spots available for non-medical GO Team members, but these team members play just as an important role as medical staff.

Participants must also obtain a valid passport. Passports that expire within six months of the travel dates will require a renewal.

HOW DO I PAY FOR THIS TRIP?

Northview Outreach believes in growing our global community to serve not only as goers, but also as senders. We firmly believe it is in the best interest and health of the GO Team participant to ask others to be a part of their global community. Asking for support from family, friends, coworkers and neighbors allows for the impact of this GO Team trip to grow exponentially. As a department, we do not organize fundraisers or provide any financial assistance for applicants. Rest assured that we will coach you through and equip you with tools to help you be successful with your personal fundraising.

ARE THERE REQUIRED VACCINATIONS?

Please contact your healthcare provider for more information and suggestions for necessary vaccinations no later than one month prior to leaving for Haiti. Recommended vaccinations or prescriptions include: Typhoid, Tetanus, Anti-Malaria Rx, and Cipro (Anti-diarrhea Rx).
