WHY ARE WE GOING?

Nicaragua has been an impoverished country for decades due to civil war and catastrophic natural disasters. We assist in helping to restore communities in Managua, Vera Cruz and La Concha. We work alongside pastors and local churches to address physical, emotional and spiritual poverty, bringing hope to Nicaragua.

WHO DO WE PARTNER WITH?

WHAT WORK WILL WE BE DOING?

The high school GO Team will come alongside pastors, school administrators and community leaders to assist and lead a teen to teen discipleship retreat. In addition, they will participate in projects that support in-country programs in the schools, churches and communities. The team will also assist in light construction work and community oriented activities with the pastors such as home visits and food distributions.

WHO CAN GO?

This trip is open to all high school students. An application should be submitted for this trip, and participants will then be selected based on that application. Our goal is to have student mission teams with varying global experience and personal talents. Participants must also obtain a valid passport. Passports that expire within six months of the travel dates will require a renewal.

HOW DO I PAY FOR THIS TRIP?

Northview Outreach believes in growing our global community to serve not only as goers, but also as senders. We firmly believe it is in the best interest and health of the GO Team participant to ask others to be a part of their global community. Asking for support from family, friends, coworkers and neighbors allows for the impact of this GO Team trip to grow exponentially. As a department, we do not organize fundraisers or provide any financial assistance for applicants. Rest assured that we will coach you through and equip you with tools to help you be successful with your personal fundraising.

ARE THERE REQUIRED VACCINATIONS?

Please contact your healthcare provider for more information and suggestions for necessary vaccinations no later than one month prior to leaving for Nicaragua. Recommended vaccinations or prescriptions include: Tetanus, Hepatitis A or A/B Combo, Anti-Malaria Rx, and Anti-Diarrhea Rx.
