Not 1st list in Bible: Gen 4:17-22; Gen 5:1-32; Gen 10; Gen 11; Gen 25; Gen 36
So What?

The Textual Issue

- Name Variations between Num 26 & 1 Chr 2-8 Several explanations... 2 of sons of Genesis are grandsons
- Difference between v26 & 27: 66 vs. 70
 Most likely: not counting Er, Onan, Ephraim, Manasseh
- Stephen in Acts 7:14 says "75"; Gen 46 says "70"

 Stephen quotes Septuagint (Grk translation of Hebrew) which reads 75

 Septuagint likely includes 9 descendants of Joseph (later) instead of just 2
- Key: God's Word is reliable, our understanding is often lacking
