To Think About & Discuss:

- Prophecy is often difficult and obscure. Prophecy should always exalt Jesus Christ and bring all into submission to Him. So how should that view affect our view and understanding and study of prophecy?
- This passage shows God's judgments (Chariots). Should believers fear God's judgment in any sense? Consider John 5:24; Romans 8:1; 1 Cor 3:10-15: 2 Cor 5:9-11.
- To what degree should we use the fear of God's coming judgment (versus God's love) in our witnessing? Hebrews 9:27
- As we look at the Chariots we see God's varied Providence. How does Romans 8:28 instruct us? How does this help when facing persecution?
- Consider Joseph's life (Genesis 37-50). Read Genesis 50:20. How does Joseph's explanation of his circumstances of life help us gain a proper perspective and attitude?
- Calvin wrote: God So Uses the Works of the Ungodly, and So Bends Their Minds to Carry Out His Judgments, That He Remains Pure From Every Stain. (Institutes 1.18.title). How do you explain God's use of evil in His Providence? Consider: Isaiah 45:7: Prov 16:33: Hab 1:13: Rom 9:19-20
- How does Christ building the temple affect your view of the Church? How should your life change if you were totally committed to building God's temple (His Church)?
- Read Psalm 2; Phil 2:5-11— what do we learn about the Kingship of Christ? How would you answer someone who argues that it does not appear that Christ is reigning as King today?
- Read Hebrews 7:23-28; 9:24-28. What do we learn about the priesthood of Christ.
