Titus: Paul wrote to outline the design for leaders & mature believers. Also wrote in 1 Timothy 3 concerning elders (1-7) and deacons (8-13). All for the purpose of growing the members of the Church: 1 Tim 4:6-11 Evervone should be "training yourself for godliness" 1 Timothy 4:7

## Godly Elders (men) & Godly believers:

- 1. Reflect spiritual maturity in our home life
- A. An Elder honors God's design for marriage "One woman man" — respects God's design for marriage: Gen 2:18-25; Mt 19:3-12; Mal 2:15; 1 Cor 7:1-12; 1 Thes 4:1-8; Heb 13:4; 2 Cor 6:14.
- B. An Elder's children reflect gracious leadership 1 Tim 3:4-5; Mt 20:25-28; Eph 6:1-4; 2 Tim 3:15
- 2. Reflect spiritual maturity in personal character
- A. Negatively, Mature believers are:
  - 1. Not arrogant or self-willed. Stubborn, opinionated, always has to have own way...
  - 2. Not quick-tempered Jms 1:19-20. Not a constant fighter – not angry quickly, listens 1st
  - 3. Not a drunkard careful & prudent use of alcohol Leaders beware: Prv 20:1; 23:29-25; 31:4-6; Drunkenness forbidden: Eph 5:18; Rm 13:13; 1 Pt 4:3; 1 Cor 6:12. Wise Use: Prv 3:9-10: Ps 104:15: Dt 14:23-26: 1 Tim 5:23
  - 4. Not violent or pugnacious Gentleness & reason, not violence should be demeanor
  - 5. Not fond of sordid gain or a lover of money Does he view himself as a steward of God's money or seek it?
- B. Positively, Mature believers strive to: 1. Be Hospitable

2. Love what is good Phil 4:8; Eph 4:24

- 3. Be self-controlled or sensible prudent, wise - 1 Tim 3:2; 2 Tim 1:7
- 4. Be upright, righteous and just Mt 1:19: Mt 5:45: Gal 3:11
- 5. Be holy or devout 1 Tim 2:8; Rev 15:4 - as in pure
- 6. Be disciplined or self-controlled 1 Cor 9:25 - athletic discipline; fruit of Spirit Gal 5:23
- 3. Reflect spiritual maturity in commitment to God's Word
- A. An Elder must encourage the sheep and give instruction 1 Tim 3:2; 5:17-18;
- B. An Elder's must rebuke those who attack Christ's Church Acts 20:28-32; Titus 1:10-16;
