 - 2 I will free you
 - 3 I will redeem you
 - 4 I will take you as my own people
 - 5 I will be your God
 - 6 I will bring you to the land I promised
 - 7 I will give it to you as a possession

The Brokenness of God’s People 9-13

- Such a sad passage v9 *because of their broken spirit...*
- Way out - Trust God: Act 16:30-31
- Common human struggle. Even prophet Habakkuk 1:13
- “Why does God remain silent?” “Why do God’s people suffer?”
- NO EASY ANSWER except God has plans, He is sovereign
- Our Hope Reminder: Eph 1:11-12
