1<sup>st</sup>: Worship God Alone — the Only True God

2<sup>nd</sup>: Worship the Right God the Right way... not with idols

#### The Third Commandment: Don't misuse God's Name

- Names are given to us naming is an act of authority
- God declares and reveals His own name to us Ex 3:14-15

### **The Third Commandment Applied:**

# The Negative

- Don't take the name of the Lord your God in vain.
- literally: You shall not life up the name of the Lord your God for nothingness
- God doesn't forbid the use of His name, only the MISUSE of His name
- Fisher: misuse=blasphemy, perjury, sinful cursings, oaths or vows
- In our culture: view God's name like a trademarked name... to honor it.
- God cares deeply about His name: Lev 24:10-16 consequences

#### The Positive

- We can learn from the opposite of what is commanded
- Hallow God's Name Mt 6:9
- Learn to properly use God's Name: Psalm 8:1; 29:2; 72:19; 103:1, etc.
- Honoring God's Name & spreading His Gospel Message are directly related!

## Making God's Name Great & Glorious:

- Jesus John 17:21-22 our mission: so that the world may believe!
- When Jesus' name is lifted up & exalted: Act 4:12; Ro 10:13; 1 Jn 5:13
- God redeems us into His Church so we're a community on mission for His glory
- Church is to be a MERCY SHIP, not a CRUISE SHIP!
  - not about our comfort & care 1<sup>st</sup>, but about God's mission
- We are to remind one-another daily of the Gospel and pray for the Gospel to be effective in our lives so that the world will see Christ in us!
- We are on mission: Remember the Gospel empowers us to serve Christ:
  - Know, believe and act upon the Gospel each day
  - Take your thoughts captive regularly 2 Cor 10:4-5; Help others...
  - Immerse yourself in the nurture of our Gospel saturated community
  - Speak the Gospel regularly to one another so others will see it

# Q. 112. What does the third commandment require?

A. The third commandment requires the holy and reverent use in our thoughts, meditations, words, and writings, of God's name, titles, qualities, regulations, word, sacraments, prayer, oaths, casting lots, taken lots, his works, and anything else by which he makes himself known. This treatment will be reflected in holy affirmations of our faith and conduct that matches our affirmations, to the glory of God and the good of ourselves and others.

### Q. 113. What particular sins does the third commandment forbid?

A. The third commandment forbids: not using God's name as is required; the abuse of it through ignorance, 2 empty3 or unholy treatment, irreverence,4 superstition,<sup>5</sup> or any wicked reference to his titles, qualities,<sup>6</sup> regulations,<sup>7</sup> or works; blasphemy; perjury; all sinful cursing, and oaths, wows, and casting lots; 14 violating our oaths and vows, if lawful, 15 and keeping them, if aimed at unlawful things; 16 complaining and guarreling about 17 or misapplication of God's decrees 18 and acts of providence 19 as well as unwarranted curiosity about them; 20 misinterpreting<sup>21</sup> or misapplying<sup>22</sup> God's word or perverting all or part of its meaning in any way;<sup>23</sup> blasphemous mockery of his word,<sup>24</sup> pointless arguing, meaningless talk, or supporting false doctrines;<sup>25</sup> abusing God's name, his creatures, or anything included under his name in the practice of magic<sup>26</sup> or to promote sinful desires and activities;<sup>27</sup> maligning,<sup>28</sup> scorning,<sup>29</sup> reviling,<sup>30</sup> or opposing in any way God's truth, grace, and actions;<sup>31</sup> pretending to be religious or using religion for evil purposes;<sup>32</sup> being ashamed of God's name<sup>33</sup> or a shame to it by stubbornly refusing to obey him<sup>34</sup> and by living unwisely,<sup>35</sup> unfruitfully,<sup>36</sup> or in such a way as to offend him<sup>37</sup> or backslide away from him.<sup>38</sup>
