A. God in Faithfulness Remembers Us

- Gen 19:29 - God remembers Abraham - spares Lot
- Gen 30:22 – God remembers Rachel - she conceived
- Ex 2:24 - God remembers Covenant - has mercy on Israel
- God always remembers His Covenant – has mercy on His own!

1. God's faithful remembering is seen in His past salvation
2. God's faithful remembering is seen in His promises of future preservation
God is the covenant keeper!
Jude 24; John 6:39; Phil 1:2, Gen 6:18; 8:21-22, etc.
