- ◆ Please note that fees must be paid for the whole term of lessons, which runs September to June. (Monthly or Lump sum)
- ◆ **NO REFUNDS** are provided for early withdrawal.
- ◆ For special request non pre-arranged monthly payments, please note that there is a \$4 per month charge for late payments.
- ◆ Family Rate: The third family member from the same family receives 10% off the above rates providing all members are taking regular weekly lessons.
- ◆ The **registration fee** entitles students of the Academy to a 10% discount off all purchases and rentals from both Academies. Students also enjoy free admission to our recitals. Discounts do not apply to lessons, gift certificates, and items on sale.
- ◆ There is a \$42.50 charge for non-sufficient fund cheques.
- ◆ Please note: Books not included in lesson fees.

INCENTIVE PROGRAMS

- ◆ **Musicians of the Month**
Students who show outstanding musical achievement and improvement are presented an award by their teachers. A certificate is presented to each student, and their names are announced in our newsletter, "Music Notes".
- ◆ **Young Performer's and Professional's Medals**
Medals are presented to students who have participated in a certain number of recitals organized by the Academy. Students earn one point for participating in the Spring or Winter Recital, Echoes of Winter Recital and a half point for playing in a mini-recital or Open House performance.
- ◆ **Young Performer's Medals**

We encourage our students to perform in all of our recitals, but participation is entirely voluntary.

EXAMINATIONS

- ◆ Students are encouraged to participate in examinations, however they are not required to do so. Our students consistently achieve excellent results.
- ◆ Examinations are conducted by The Royal Conservatory of Music, & Trinity College London.
- ◆ Kanata Music Academy is the Trinity College London Examination Center for the Ottawa-Hull region.
- ◆ Information on examinations, syllabus as well as application forms are available.

MISSED LESSON POLICY

- ◆ Students are responsible to pay for the time-slot being held for them. That is, the number of lessons that are in each month, not the number of lessons they are present for.
- ◆ Twenty-four hours notice is required to receive a make-up lesson. Last minute cancellations will not be accommodated.
- ◆ Make-up classes will be scheduled as soon as the teacher is available, or on the designated make-up day. Make-up classes must be taken before June 30th, or the lesson will be charged. Make-up classes, once scheduled, cannot be rebooked.
- ◆ Students may reschedule a maximum of four lessons throughout the school year. Once four lessons have been rescheduled for whatever reason, students will be charged for the time slot being held for them.
- ◆ Make-up classes cannot be taken in lieu of regular lessons.
- ◆ For lengthy vacations / absences (2 weeks or more), if make-up lessons are not feasible, the student risks losing their designated timeslot. Two weeks notice is required.
- ◆ If the teacher is absent, the Academy will either assign a substitute teacher or arrange a make-up lesson.
- ◆ Make-up classes/credits are not available for group lessons.

WITHDRAWAL POLICY

- ◆ A minimum of two weeks notice is required to terminate lessons. Students will be charged for the two weeks proceeding the notice of termination, regardless of whether or not they are present.
- ◆ Students are considered to be continuing lessons if no notice is provided. Students will be held accountable for the lesson fees incurred.
- ◆ There will be **NO REFUNDS**. Store credit will be provided for the remaining lesson fees. Group lesson fees are not eligible for store credit.
