Completed in 1976, "Memories of Avon" quilt was a community project under the sponsorship of The Avon Historical Society.

From Avon photographs, 1814-1914, black and white drawings on paper were made by artist Betty Sheak. Volunteers selected a drawing then given free reign as to background, type of needlework and materials to interpret the chosen block.
