# Drama Club

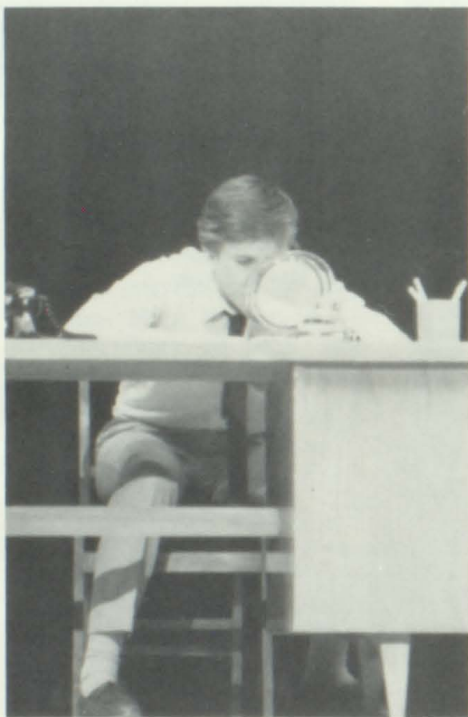

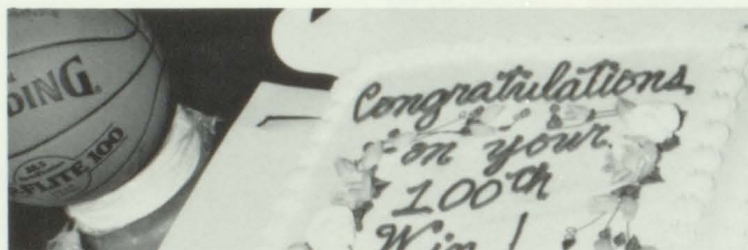
# ASKETBALL

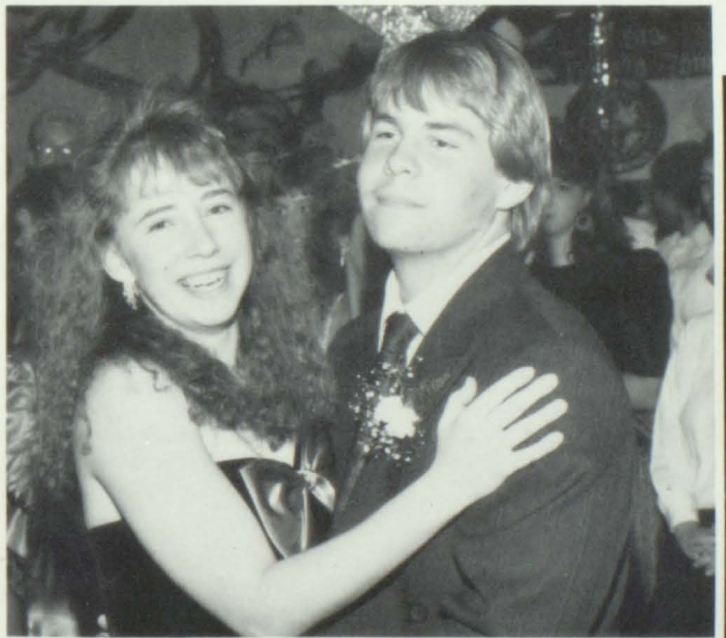
