### TIME-SHEET

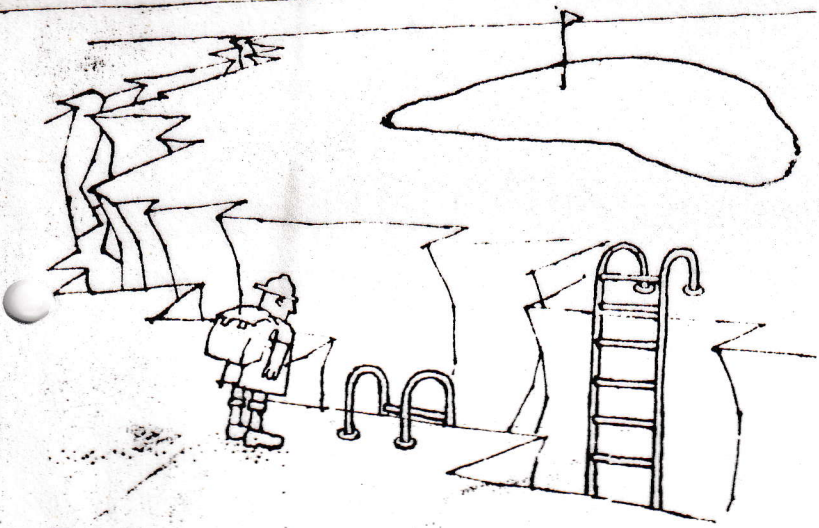
In future only members whose names appear on the time-sheet will be entitled to play on Sunday mornings.
