Keep Winter Park Beautiful continues to sponsor three levels of Ballroom Dance lessons. On Tuesday evenings at the Winter Park Farmers Market, the beginner lessons are offered from 7-8:30 p.m. and the advanced basic lessons are offered from 8:45-9:45 p.m. The Thursday evening advanced intermediate level lessons at the Lake Island Center will feature a one-dance class from 7-8 p.m. and a newly added style and technique class from 8:15-9:15 p.m.

The beginner lessons cover the waltz, rumba, fox trot, cha-cha and swing. The advanced basic class focuses on two selected dances that change every session, and the Thursday night advanced intermediate dance class concentrates on one

dance which changes each session. Instructor Stuart Nichols explained, "Although we felt we offered a well-rounded program, with the rising interest in ballroom dancing, there clearly is a demand for a style and techniques class."

The nominal class fee for all of lessons is \$50 per person for the eight week session. The beginner and advanced basic sessions begin on Aug. 22 and Oct. 17. The advanced intermediate One Dance, and Style and Technique sessions begin on Aug. 17, and Oct. 5.
