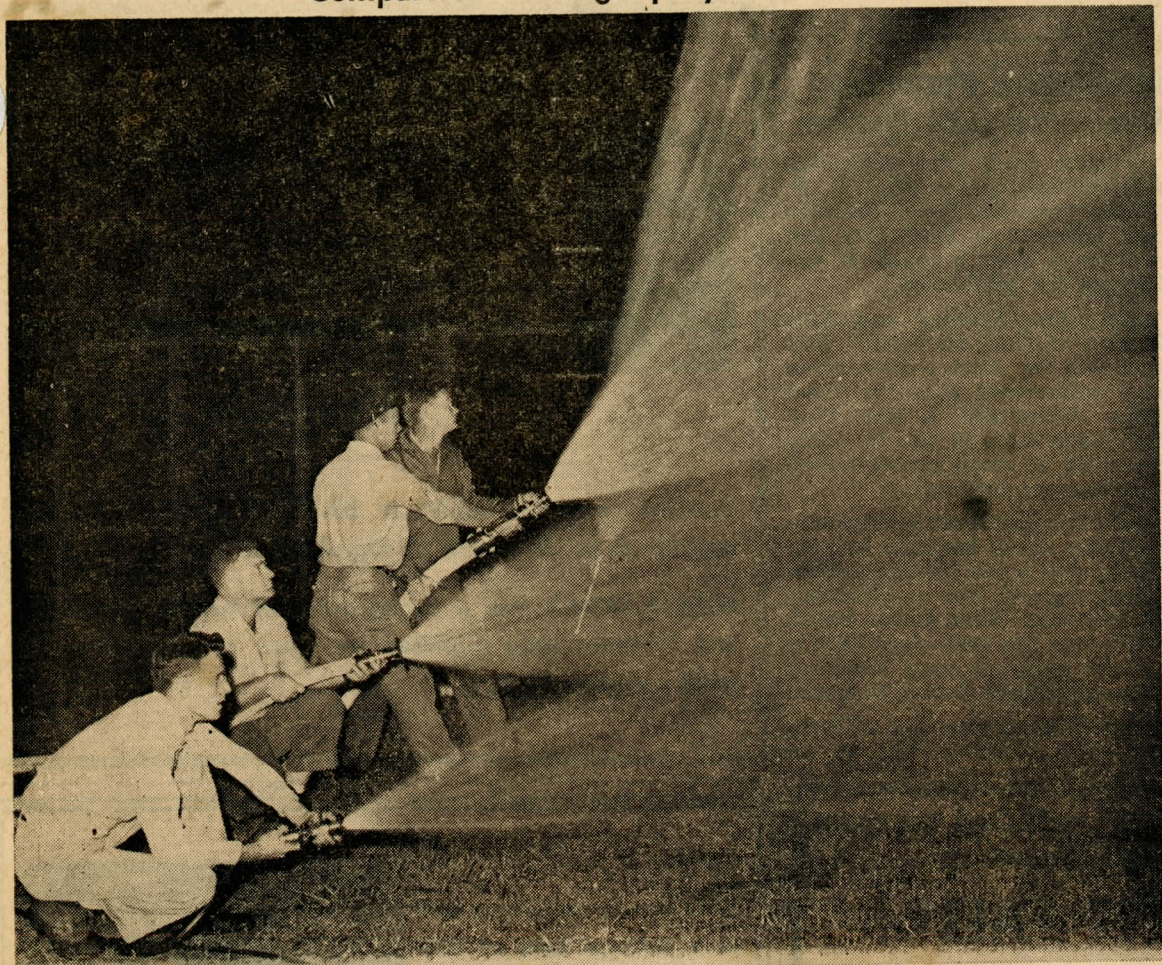

Comparison In Fog Spray Nozzles

Winter Park firemen demonstrate comparative water power of four nozzles in use at the fire department. At left Bruce Churchill holds a nozzle spraying $17\frac{1}{2}$ gallons per minute; and in order, Red O'steen with 98-gallon nozzle, Ed Ballard and 210-gallon, and at back, Fred Cook holds the new "Jumbo" nozzle pouring 475 gallons per minute. The new nozzle can reach 140 feet in a straight line and used between a burning building and an adjoining one, can prevent even blistering paint on neighboring areas, according to Fire Chief Allan Erwin.
