✓ County Seeks Lights For WP Interchanges

Orange County is ready and willing to pickup the tab for lighting Interstate 4 from the Orlando north city limits through Fairbanks and Lee Road interchanges, except--there are no lights.

Comm. John Talton, acting chairman of the county commission, called this to the attention of Richey Green, district State Road Department engineer, this week and got a promise that a check would be under-way immediately.

Talton said a resolution from the County was being prepared and forwarded agreeing to supply current, just as is being done on the section from Orlando's south limits through the Orange Blossom Trail interchange.

In some manner lights were left out of the Interstate 4 Winter Park contracts. They are installed north to Par Avenue. The super highway abruptly goes dark there--although ahead are two interchanges expected to be among the most heavily used between St. Petersburg and Daytona Beach.

No part of the road is in Winter Park.

Green thought it would be considerable time before a light project could be added, Talton said. In addition to State Road Department approval, the Bureau of Public Roads' must be obtained.
