Maps update where you are in Winter Park

eep Winter Park Beautiful has revised and updated a map of the city. It is the first revision in 30 years

"The old map still showed the Kmart Plaza as J.M. Fields Plaza, and with the Winter Park Pines neighborhood, you could never find all the streets," said map Chairwoman Linda King. "Lots of people were really confused by it."

At 36 inches by 26 inches, the new map features updated street listings and points of interest, including museums, schools, shopping areas and recreational facilities. It also includes a list of the buildings in the city that are part of the National Register of Historic Buildings, a brief history of the city and a guide to the businesses that advertised on its cover.
