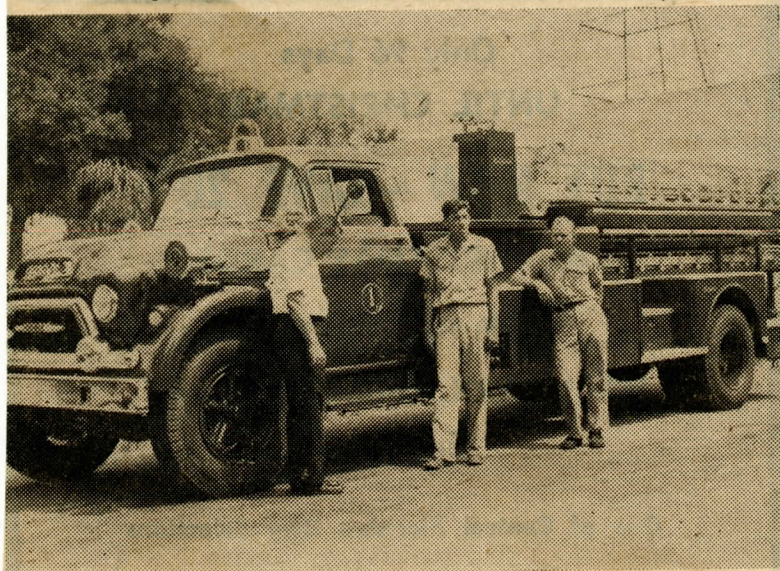

TWO FIREMEN OUT—

Two Winter Park firemen were placed on the suspension list last week by Fire Chief Robert S. Bair. They are Capt. E. R. Ballard, Maitland, and Engineer Donald Youngs, Winter Park. Ballard's suspension came Wednesday, March 19, and Youngs' on Thursday, March 20. Ballard has been with the department about seven years, Youngs about two years.

In an interview, Chief Bair would only comment, "I released them for violaton of Civil Service rules and regulations".

The discharged men are entitled to a hearing before the Civil Service board within 10 days, but at press time no such hearing had been asked for, according to a board member.
