

## Investigators to delve into complaint on firefighters

WINTER PARK — The city's Civil Service Board agreed Tuesday to launch an investigation regarding a complaint that firefighters watched pornographic movies on the job.

Public Safety Director Jim Younger will handle the investigation, but the firefighters who want to can meet with Civil Service Board Chief Examiner Larry Moseley.

The board, which convened the special meeting to deal with a Feb. 28 complaint from a local attorney, asked both men to try to report back by next month.

City officials have said the incident in the letter happened years ago and that no pornographic tapes are shown in the stations now. On Tuesday, the president of the Winter Park firefighters union submitted a statement also saying the incident was isolated.
