

Company inspects repaired fire truck

WINTER PARK — Inspection of the fire department's only tower truck began Friday and was being completed Tuesday by National Testing of Columbus, Ohio.

The truck was returned to Winter Park July 25 after being out of service since April 15 for repairs at the city garage.

Last month Fire Chief Mike Molthop told City Manager David Harden that

the garage was taking three months to complete the repairs.

Molthop said the truck, which is used to fight fires in tall buildings and rescue people, has been back in service since its return to the department but there have been no calls for its use.

The \$1,000 inspection was already budgeted to take place this year, Molthop said.
