

Lake Program Goes Forward by Experts

Chief Biologist John F. Dequine of the State Game and Fresh Water Fish Commission has completed a preliminary survey of lakes within the city limits of Winter Park in line with Mayor Oliver K. Eaton's campaign to make each Winter Park lake produce the maximum amount of sport fishing. Soundings were taken in Lakes Sylvan, Maitland, Osceola, Mizell and Virginia, to determine what is required for each lake. Soundings taken by the experts discovered Lake Sylvan the deepest lake in the city, with depths of 27 feet recorded.

Seinings will be taken to determine the amount of rough and game fish, and the results will determine what procedures will be necessary for the stocking of each lake.

The underwater weed cutting boat has arrived and work will begin next week on clearing lakes.
