

## K.W.P.B. wins "Best Theme" award at Central Florida Fair

In February, with little more than two weeks notice, Keep Winter Park Beautiful agreed to showcase the City of Winter Park at the Central Florida Fair.

K.W.P.B.'s display was awarded the "1999 Theme Award of Excellence". Central Florida Fair booth criteria to win this award was that the booths display the ways in which the community invests in the future.

To be eligible for an award, an exhibit had to incorporate the categories: "A Commitment to Our Future" - the 1999 Fair theme, Education, Community History and Recent Developments, Agriculture and Ecology.

## City receives award for W.P.H.S. "Dinner Out" program

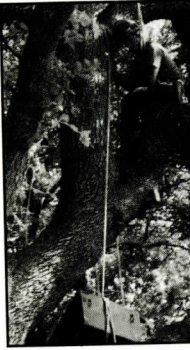
