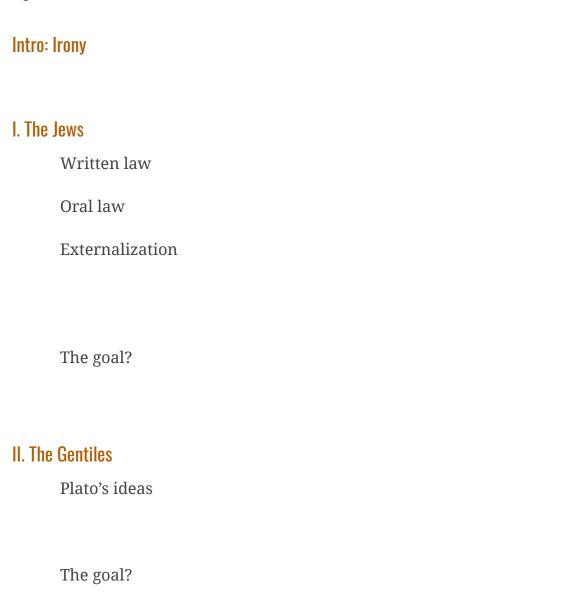
Finding Righteousness
