

The Columbia Kootenay Cultural Alliance (CKCA) partners with the Columbia Basin Trust, which provides funding to the CKCA to deliver arts, culture and heritage funding to residents of the Canadian Columbia Basin. The CKCA, which is an umbrella organization of arts, culture and heritage sector representatives, carries out programs that each year result in the creation of more than one hundred cultural projects.

The CKCA has an elected steering committee, which works to determine cultural funding needs throughout the region, and recommends arts, culture and heritage funding programs to the Columbia Basin Trust. Once these programs are approved, the Columbia Basin Trust relies on the expertise of the CKCA Steering Committee to determine which projects will receive funding.

To date, the Columbia Basin Trust and the Columbia Kootenay Cultural Alliance have delivered over one million dollars to residents of the Columbia Basin in the cultural sector.
