*The CKCA has an elected steering committee, which works to determine cultural funding needs throughout the region, and recommends arts, culture and heritage funding programs to the Columbia Basin Trust. Once these programs are approved, the Columbia Basin Trust relies on the expertise of the CKCA Steering Committee to determine which projects will receive funding.*

*To date, the Columbia Basin Trust and the Columbia Kootenay Cultural Alliance have delivered over one and a half million dollars to residents of the Columbia Basin in the cultural sector.*
