The CKCA partners with the Columbia Basin Trust to deliver arts, culture and heritage funding to the residents of the Canadian Columbia Basin.

The CKCA, an umbrella association of arts, culture and heritage sector representatives, carries out programs that each year result in the creation of more than 100 cultural projects.

The CKCA has an established steering committee, which works to determine cultural funding needs throughout the region and recommends cultural programs to the Columbia Basin Trust. Once these programs are approved, the CBT relies on the expertise of the CKCA committee to determine which projects will receive arts, culture and heritage funding.

To date, the Columbia Basin Trust and the CKCA have delivered almost 3/4 of a million dollars to residents of the Columbia Basin in the cultural sector.
