The CKCA has an elected steering committee, which works to determine cultural funding needs throughout the region and recommends arts, culture and heritage programs to the Columbia Basin Trust. Once these programs are approved, the Columbia Basin Trust relies on the expertise of the Cultural Alliance committee to determine which projects will receive funding.

To date, the Columbia Basin Trust and the CKCA have delivered almost one million dollars to residents of the Columbia Basin in the cultural sector.
